Model Program Implementation:

- * Administration of student assessments
- * Meeting of registration/submission deadlines
- * Completion of stakeholder feedback surveys

Robust Program Participation:

- * Completion of all [Adventures in Health Science and Medicine®](#) Connected Learning sessions and the IDEA\$ Challenge; or
- * Completion of 4 or more [Dangerous Decibels®](#) sessions; or
- * Completion of [eXpressions®](#) program by 30 or more students in 1 submission category, 20 or more students in 2 submission categories, or 10 or more students in all 3 submission categories (Art, Language, and Math); or
- * Completion of the Judging Innovation program; or
- * Completion of 3 or more [Health Unleashed!™](#) lessons, engaging a total of 30 or more students; or
- * Completion of 10 or more [Worldwide Classroom®](#) sessions.
